

What is **BLAST**

- **Mission:** Building Leaders and Serving Together (BLAST) is an organization designed to empower youth ages 8-17 years old to develop leadership skills through organizing their own community service projects.
- How it Works: Each member will take on a specific role on the team, integral to the organization of the volunteer project (i.e. marketing, operations, finance, development). As youth focus on their role within the planning of their volunteer project, they will have an opportunity to interact with adult volunteers with specialized knowledge in that respective area. This structure has the added benefit of teaching youth about various career paths, while they organize and lead their volunteer projects.

Other Ways to Give

- Sponsor a leader–Tuition for BLAST for the year is \$720. Provide a scholarship for a leader in need.
- Fund a Community Service Project– Provide the financial backing for the ways that the youth want to impact their community.
- Fund a full BLAST session— \$180/ child covers 6 2-hour meetings, the project and the team building activity.
- Sponsor the team building activity— After we serve, we take the kids out for a day of fun where they are able to discuss the impact and outcome of their project then enjoy their team. We budget \$30 per child to fund the activity and lunch.
